


signature unless one of the parties notifies, in writing, of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding at least six (6) months prior to the intended date of termination.

- c) Prior to the date of expiry, the parties may negotiate to extend the Memorandum of Understanding.
- d) If a Party does not wish to extend the Memorandum of Understanding, that Party will use reasonable endeavours to notify the other Party of that intention three (3) months before the date of expiry of the Memorandum of Understanding.



Angkor Project 2024 to 2028 Memorandum of Understanding

Memorandum of Understanding between
Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport of the Kingdom of Cambodia, and
Western Australia Department of Education.

1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding records the current understandings between the Parties and is a record of their intentions in respect of the issues described in this Memorandum of Understanding.

2. Objectives

The objectives of the Memorandum of Understanding are to:

- a) Promote cooperation in education between MoEYS and Department of Education Western Australia;
- b) Build capacity in the Cambodia education system; and
- c) Establish cultural awareness between Western Australia and Cambodia.

3. Legally

The parties acknowledge and agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to and does not create legally binding relations between the parties and is non justifiable. To remove any doubt in the matter it is intended by the parties, and it is the case that, nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding is legally bending at any party hereto. This clause applies despite any other express or implied provisions to the contrary.

4. Areas of Cooperation

The parties will use reasonable endeavours to develop bilateral programs that will focus on:

- 4.1 Leadership and Teacher Competency
- 4.2 School Health
- 4.3 Cultural Awareness and Understanding

4.1 Leadership and Teacher Competency

In the area of Leadership and Teacher Competency these programs may include:



- a) Professional development
- b) Peer support programs; and
- c) Quality assurance processes

4.2 School Health

In the area of School Health these programs may include;

- a) Physical environment and infrastructure; and
- b) Curriculum, programs, policy and support materials.

4.3 Cultural Awareness and Understanding

In the area of Cultural Awareness and Understanding these programs may include:

- a) Sister school relationships
- b) Study tour relationships

The parties will also use reasonable endeavours to develop any form of cooperation as may be mutually determined.

5. Arrangement of Programs

Details of any programs will be arranged through the Director General of Education in Cambodia and the Direct General of the Western Australia Department of Education and will be subject to the approval of both parties.

6. Expenses

The parties will use reasonable endeavours, having regard to the availability of funds, to mutually determine how the costs of cooperative activities under this Memorandum of Understanding are to be funded.

7. Revision or Amendment

Either party may request in writing a revision or an amendment of the Memorandum of Understanding.

The parties will negotiate in good faith with a view to reducing any revisions or amendment in writing. Such revisions or amendment will come into effect on such date as may be determined by both parties.

8. Settlement of Disputes

The parties agree to reasonable endeavours to settle any differences or dispute arising out of or in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding amicably by consultation or negotiation between the parties.

9. Entry into Force, Duration and Termination

- a) This Memorandum of Understanding will enter force on the date of signature.
- b) The Memorandum of Understanding shall expire five (5) years after the date of
